



Educator Resource Guide

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) in collaboration with Texas PBS has compiled the following resource links to assist educators interested in learning more about the opportunities available in the free pbslearningmedia.org platform. This collaboration is meant to benefit students who are now learning at home while schools remain closed due to the spread of novel coronavirus.

In exploring these resources, educators should:

- Review all materials to determine if they will be an appropriate fit based on student need (e.g., skill-level, available accessibility features, etc.)
- Consider which students will have access to the material when assigning work directly related to content found online. A plan may need to be developed to deliver alternative materials to students who cannot access online content due to a lack of internet connectivity.
- Confirm with district technology officers that the PBS site is accessible to students using district provided internet.
