Andrew K. Pantelis is the 4th District Vice President for the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF). Elected in 2016, Pantelis represents more than 32,000 professional fire fighters and emergency medical workers from 200 affiliates in Delaware, Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia and the District of Columbia. He also concurrently serves as a battalion chief with the Prince George's County Fire and EMS Department.

As a District Vice President, Pantelis has served on numerous IAFF committees, including as chair of the Ethical Practices Committee (EPC), where he has worked to ensure a member-centric, mission-focused and transparent union. He has also served as a member and chair of the National Fire Academy's (NFA) Board of Visitors and on several local and state transition teams for two county executives, two mayors and one governor.

Prior to his election as IAFF vice president, Pantelis served as the president of the Prince George's County Professional Fire Fighters and Paramedics Association Local 1619 and as vice president of the Professional Fire Fighters of Maryland.
